





## **Donor Bill of Rights**

**The Florida Keys Outreach Coalition (FKOC) believes Philanthropy is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the FKOC and the programs they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have the right:**

- **To be informed of FKOC's mission, vision and core values; of the way we intend to use donated resources; and of our capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.**
- **To be informed of the identity of those serving on the FKOC Board of Directors, and to expect the Board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.**
- **To have access to FKOC's most recent financial statements.**
- **To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.**
- **To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.**
- **To expect that all relationships with individuals representing FKOC will be professional in nature.**
- **To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of FKOC or hired solicitors.**
- **To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.**
